PSO will use our makerspace to develop the mindset of students to look at the world through taking it apart learning how it works. Our makerspace will allow our kinesthetic, visual, logical, and social learners to have a place to learn in a very tactile, collaborative and self-directed way. The makerspace includes areas for Arts & Crafts, Textiles & Sewing, Electronics & Robotics and Woodworking & Construction. We can't wait for our students to use the space to create, invent, tinker, explore and discover. Teachers will sign up to use the space with their classes.
